Buckfast Abbey

Buckfast Abbey dates back to 1088 and is home to the well known Benedictine monastic community that is based there.

It was therefore a great privilege for Taunton Fabrications to be able to work closely with architects and engineers on the design, manufacture and installation of a canopy structure for the Abbey – one that would give a modern feel without impacting on the beauty of its surroundings. The canopy is supported on tree-like timber columns, each sporting eight 'branches' and the blend of Douglas Fir timber, galvanised steel and the **opaque glass roof** produces a stunning result.



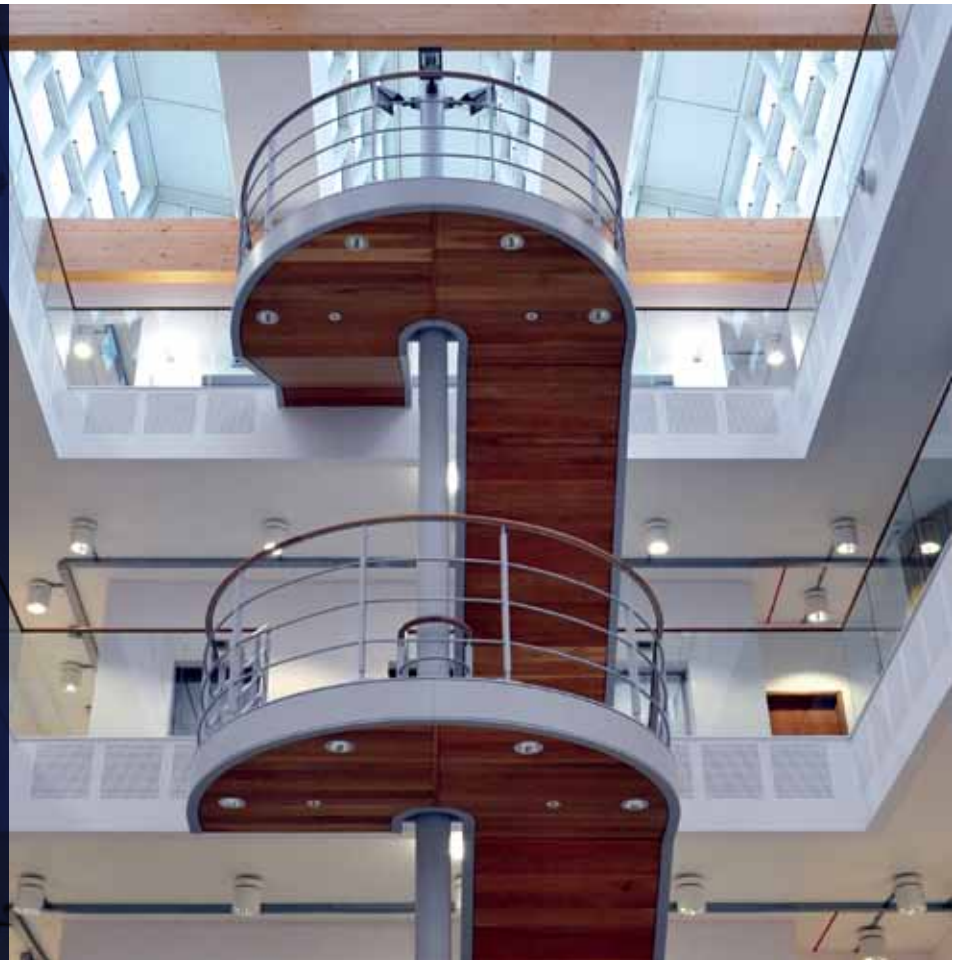

Cabot House Bristol

We were extremely pleased to have been appointed as principal secondary and architectural metalwork sub-contractor on this major city centre development.

The scheme comprises a 6,600m² corporate office for the Environment Agency, 78 apartments in two central residential blocks and a 2,500m² office block. The contract ran over an 18 month duration and included the main feature atrium stair, 200 metres of **structural glazing**, stainless steel and **glass balcony balustrades**, back of house circulation stair structures and roof terrace balustrade.
